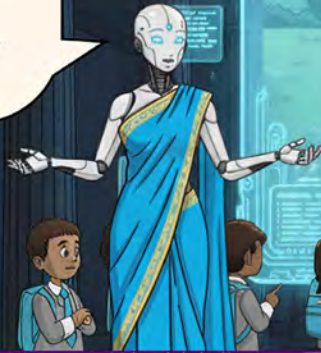




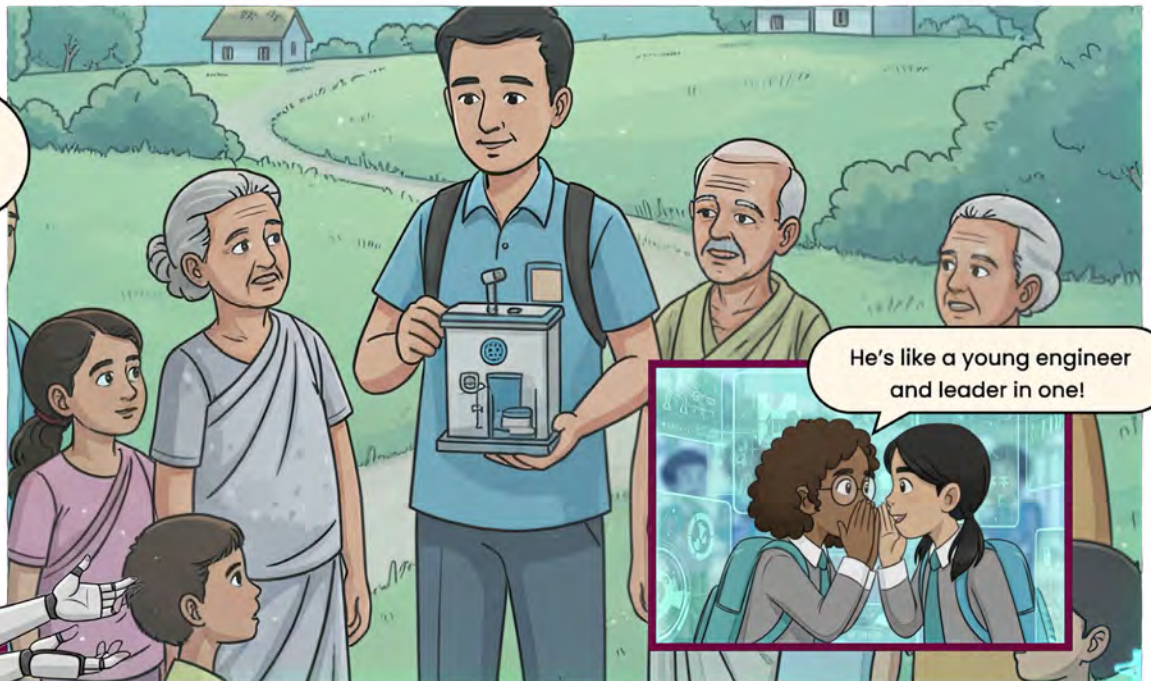
Rapid Urbanization

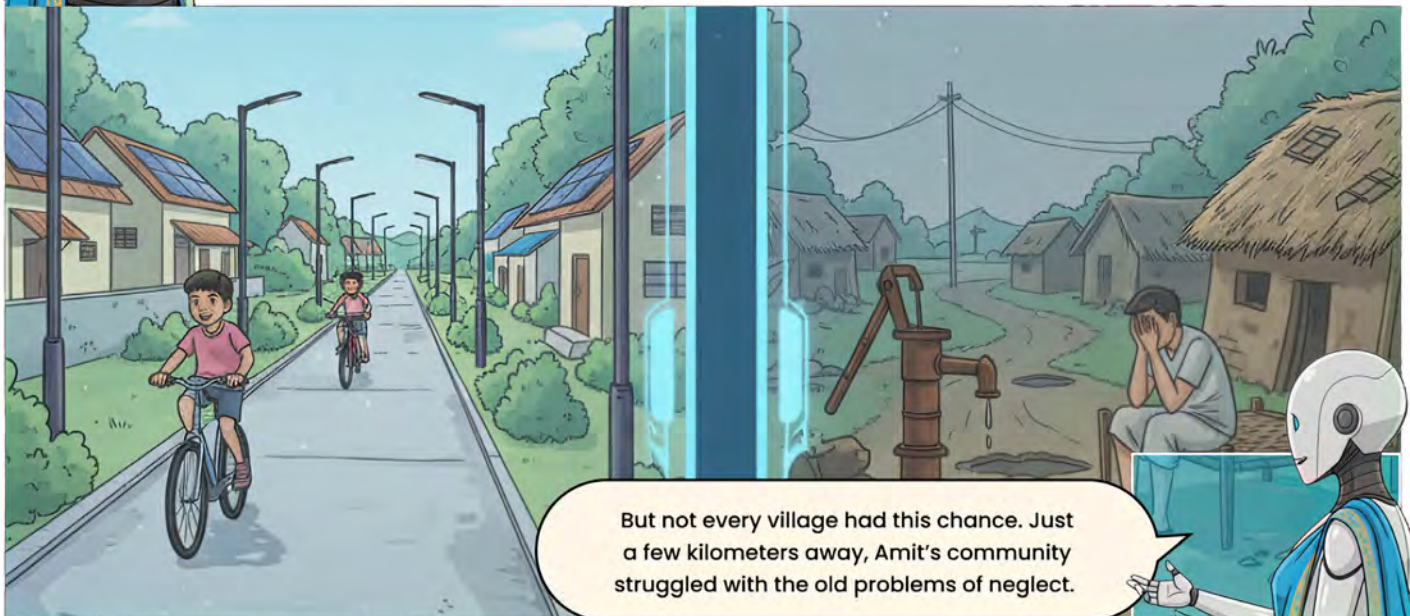

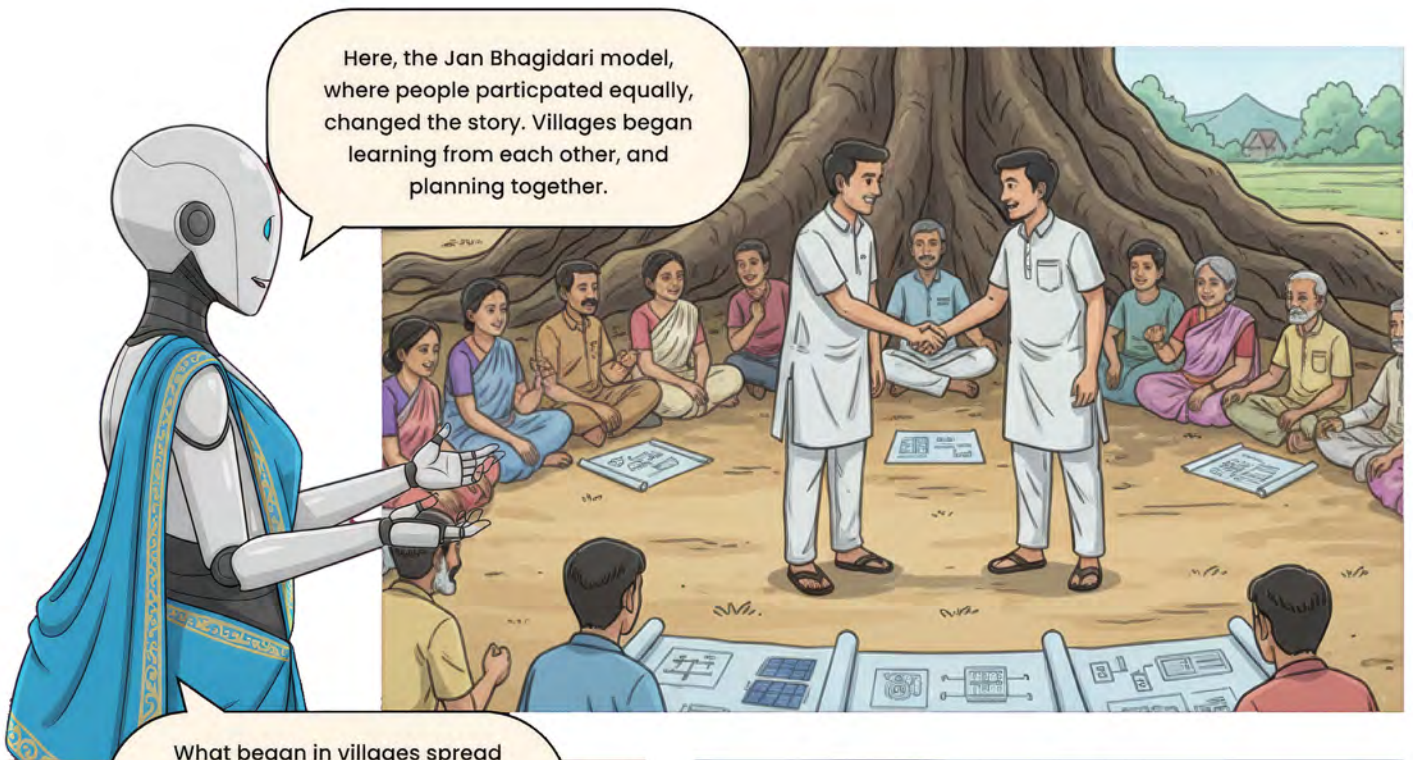
Instead of leaving for the city, Rahul brought solutions back.



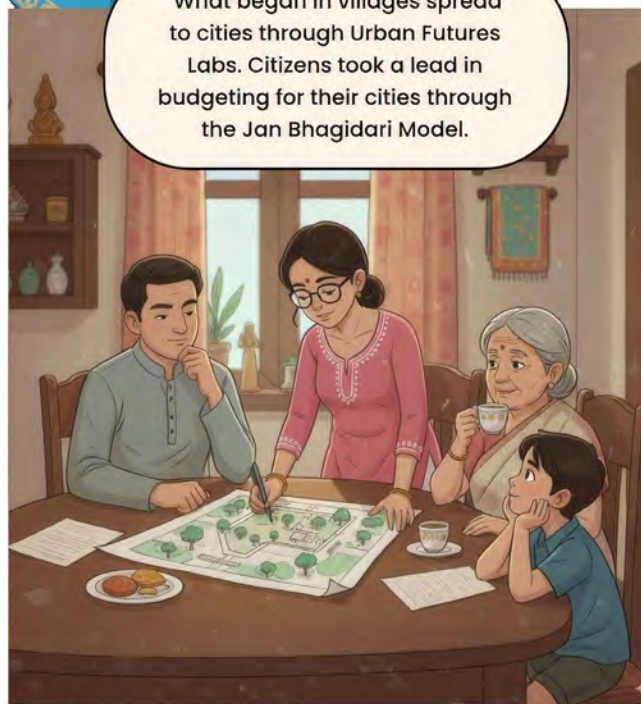
He's like a young engineer and leader in one!



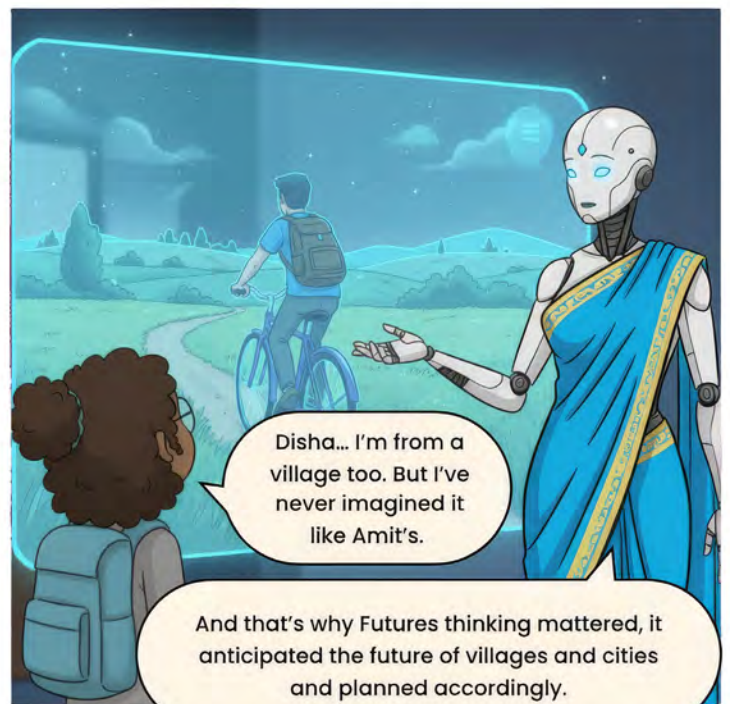
But not every village had this chance. Just a few kilometers away, Amit's community struggled with the old problems of neglect.



Here, the Jan Bhagidari model, where people participated equally, changed the story. Villages began learning from each other, and planning together.

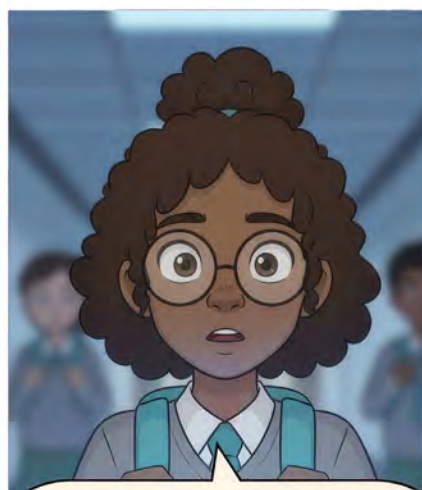


What began in villages spread to cities through Urban Futures Labs. Citizens took a lead in budgeting for their cities through the Jan Bhagidari Model.

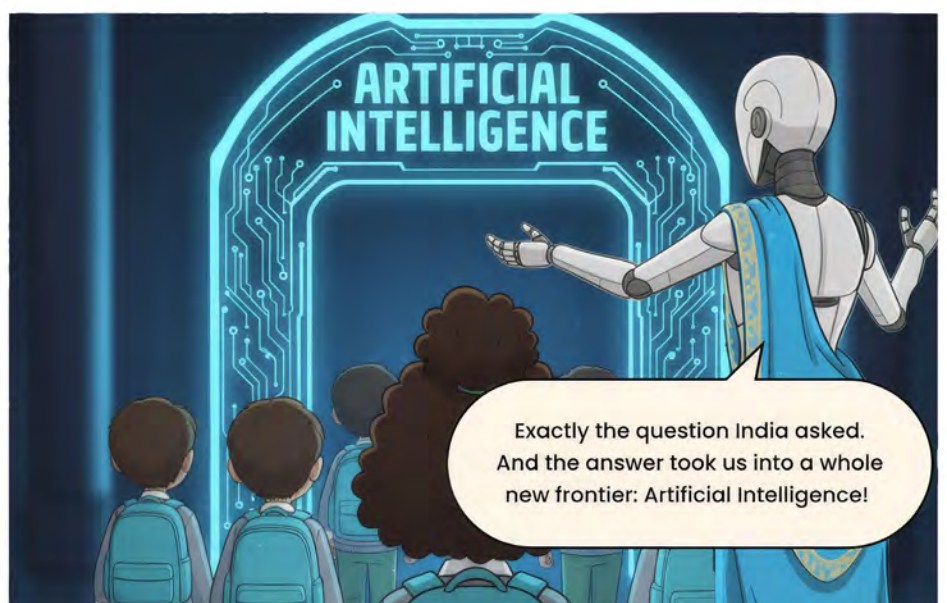


Disha... I'm from a village too. But I've never imagined it like Amit's.

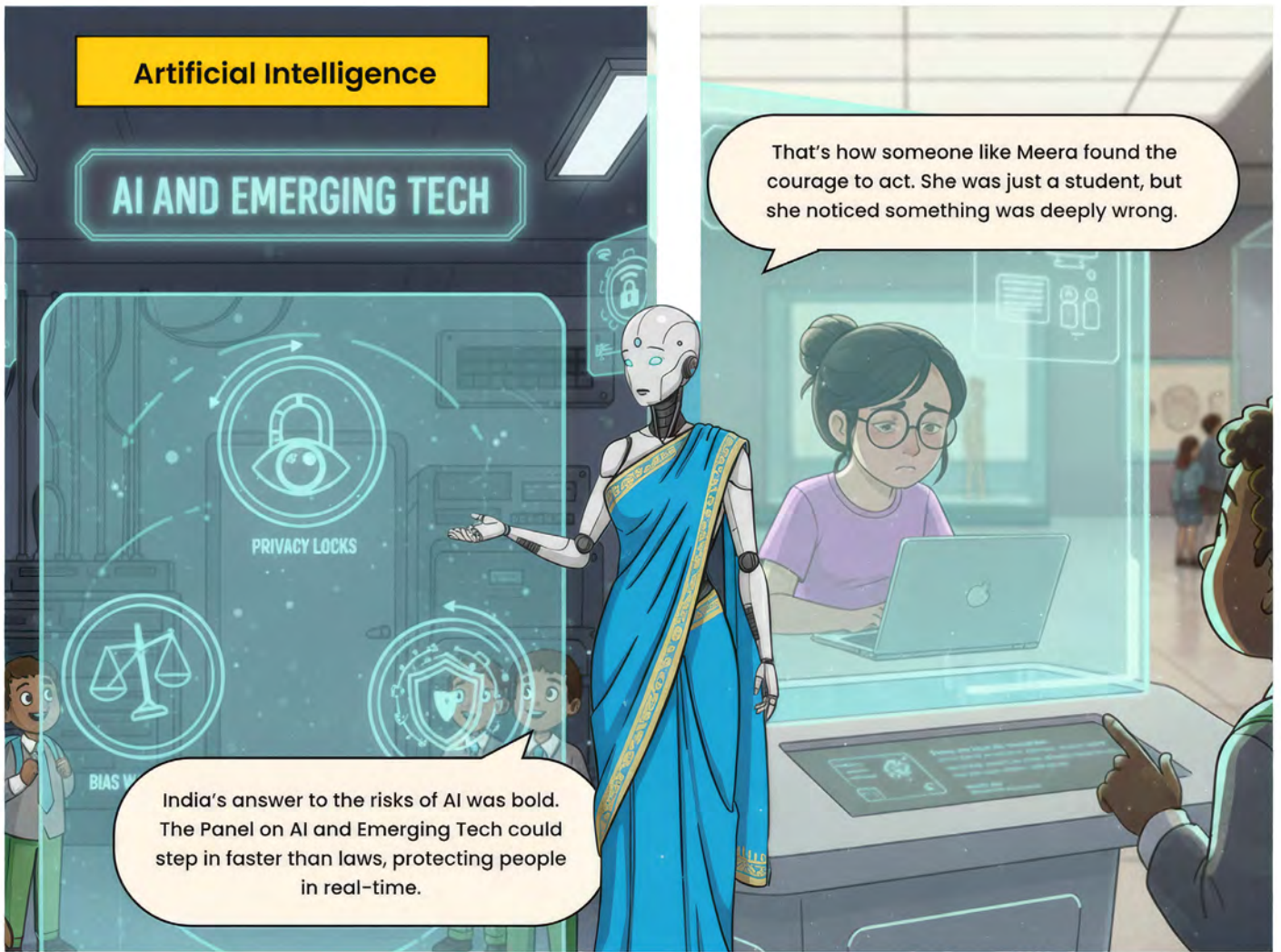
And that's why Futures thinking mattered, it anticipated the future of villages and cities and planned accordingly.



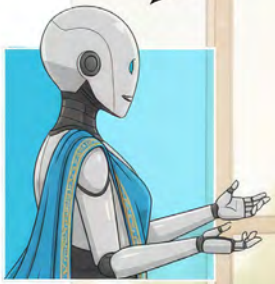
If villages and cities could change so much... what about everything else? What about the things even bigger than us?

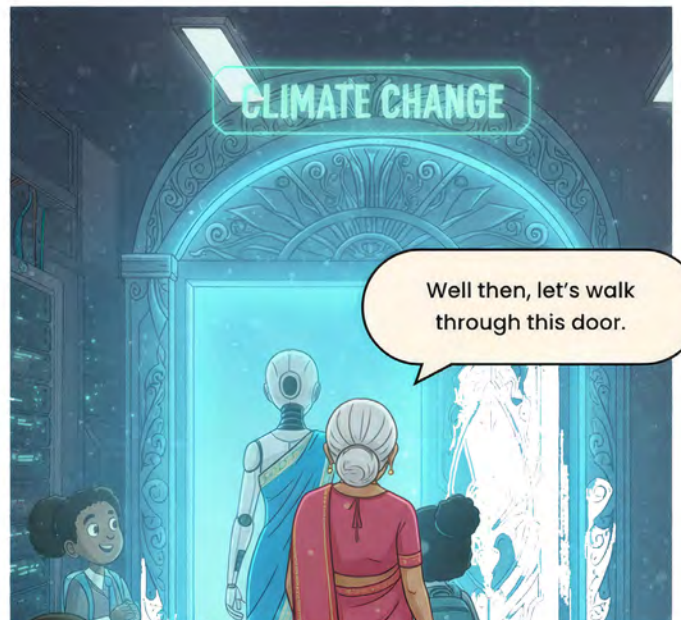

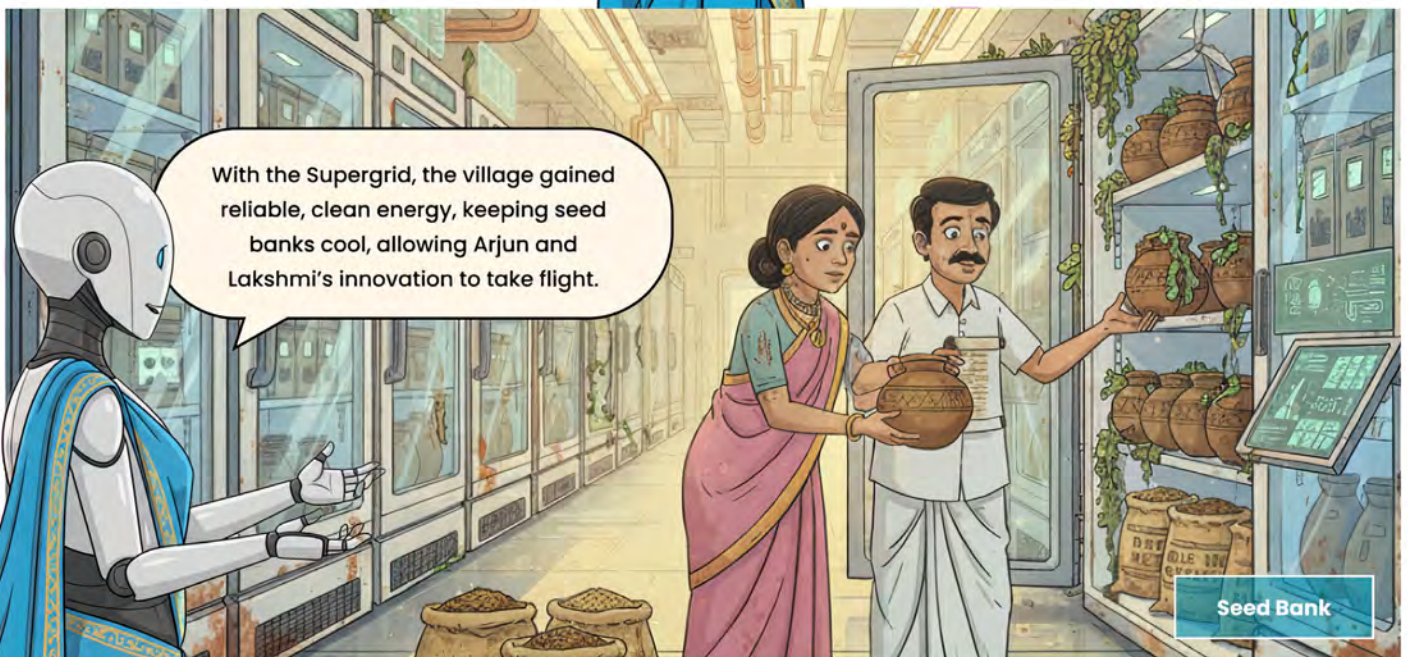
Climate Change

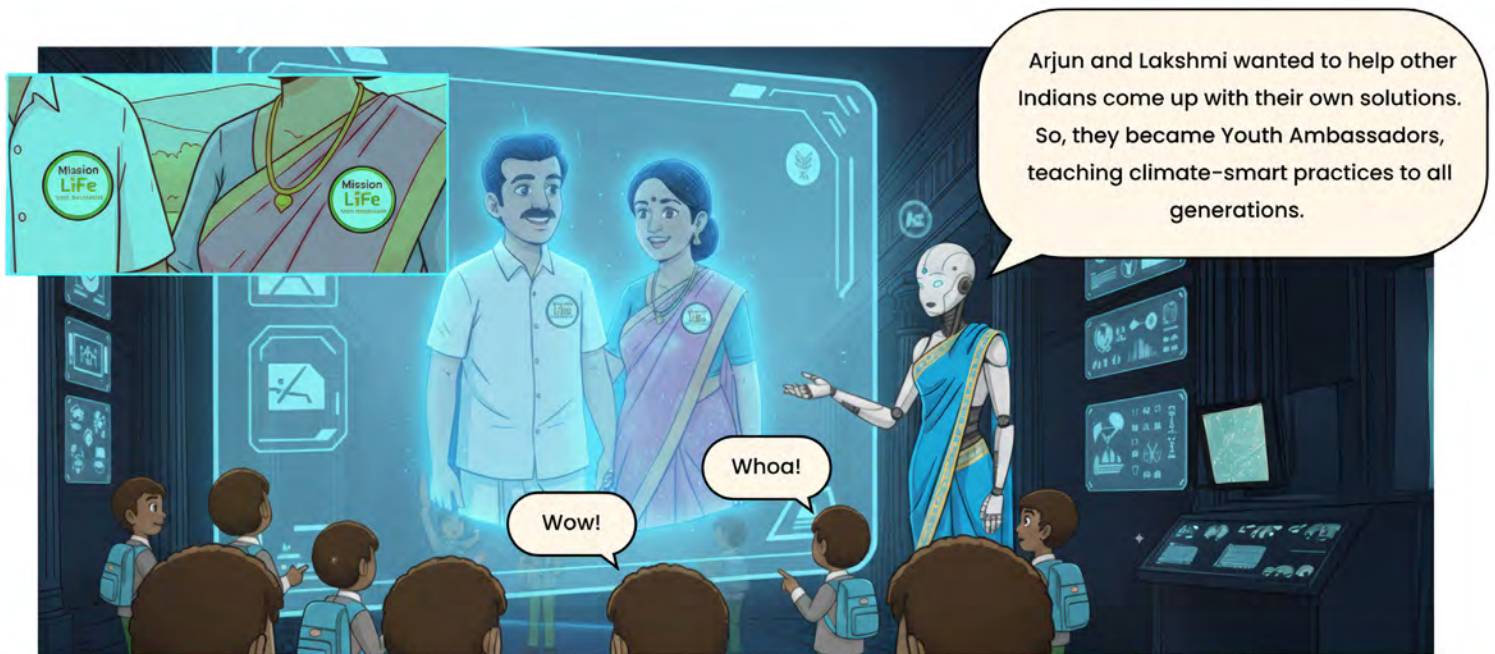
India's climate disruptions were becoming urgent. But local knowledge and modern solutions could turn the tide.

With the Supergrid, the village gained reliable, clean energy, keeping seed banks cool, allowing Arjun and Lakshmi's innovation to take flight.



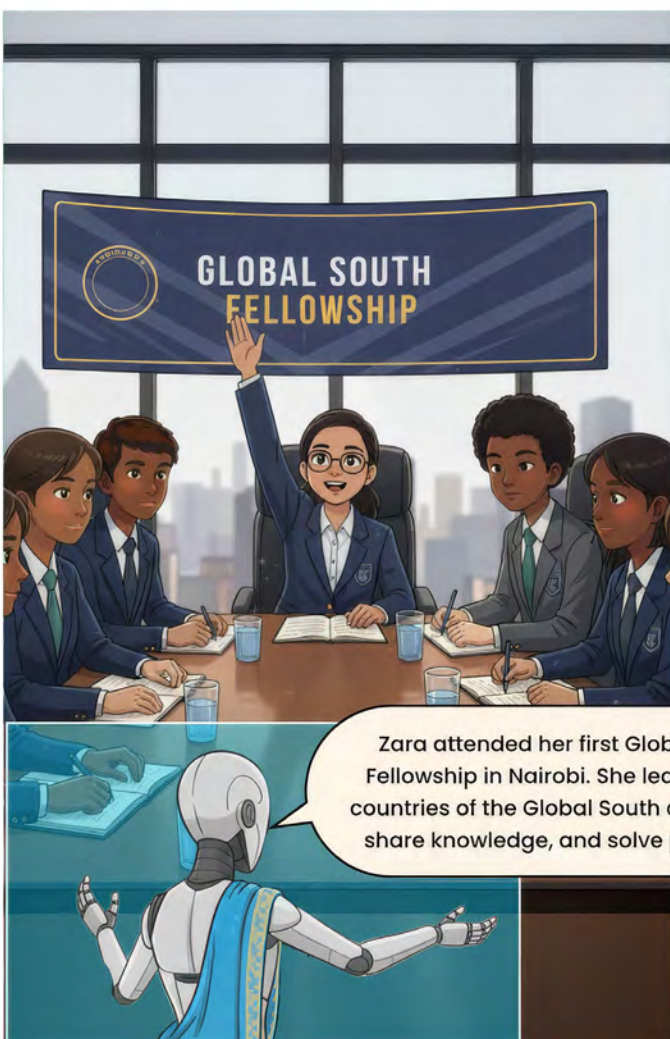

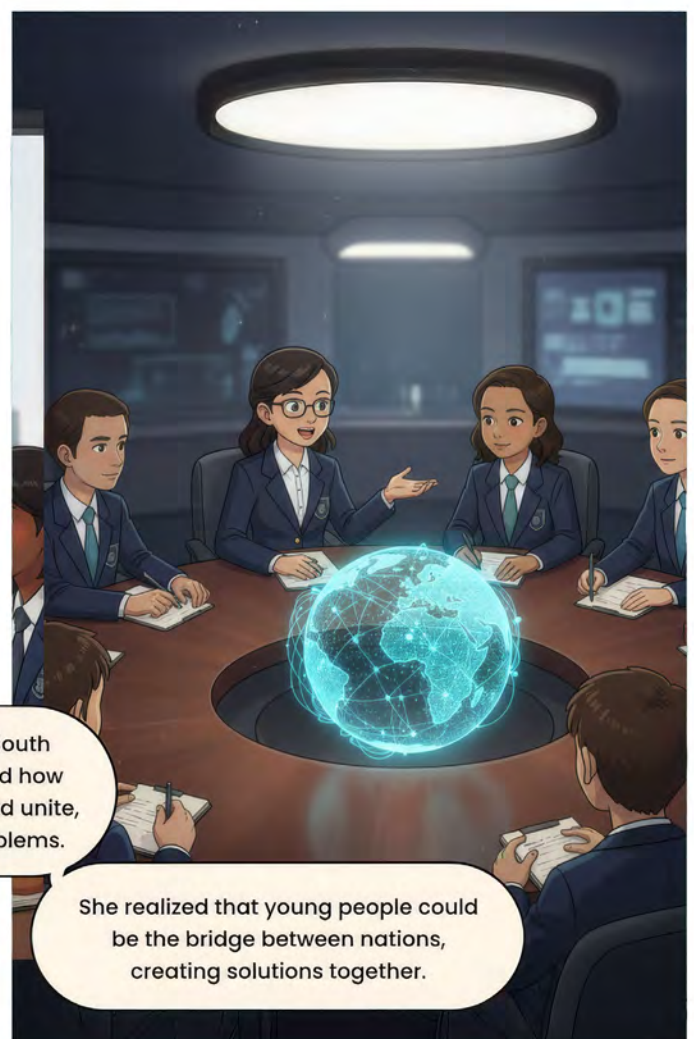
Zara, PM

No way! That's the current PM when she was a student.

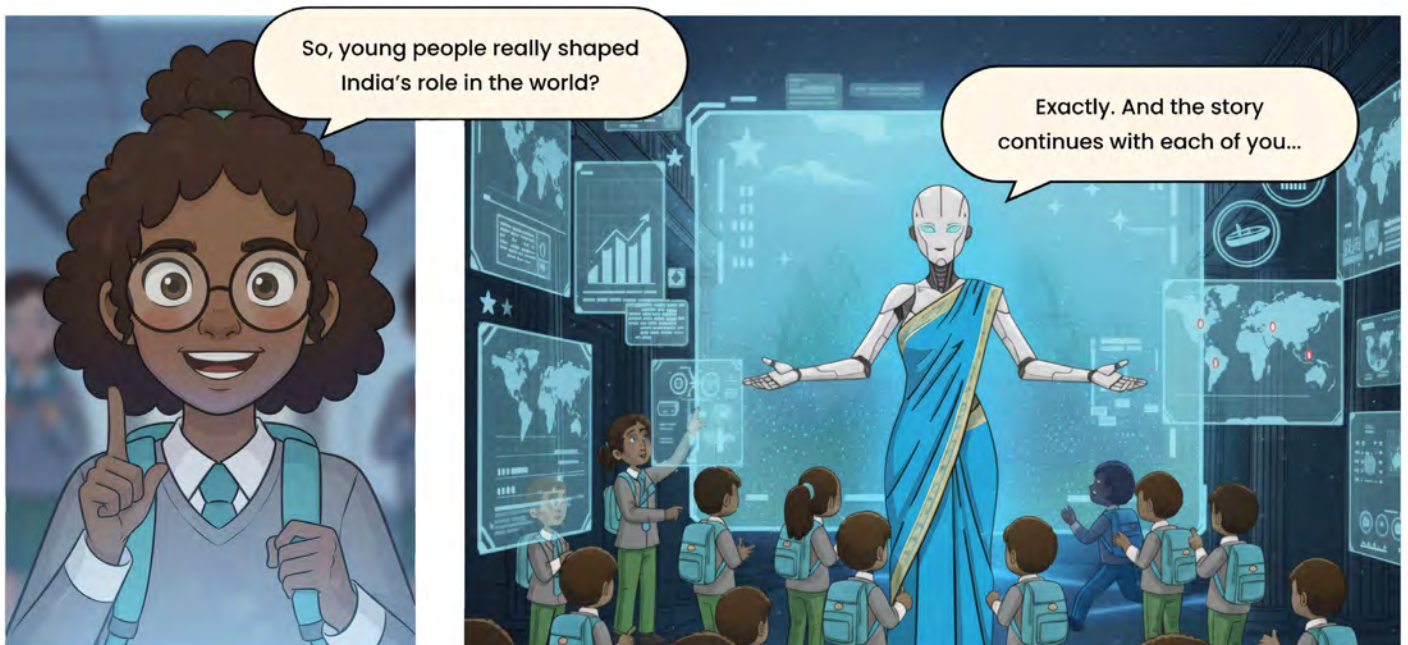
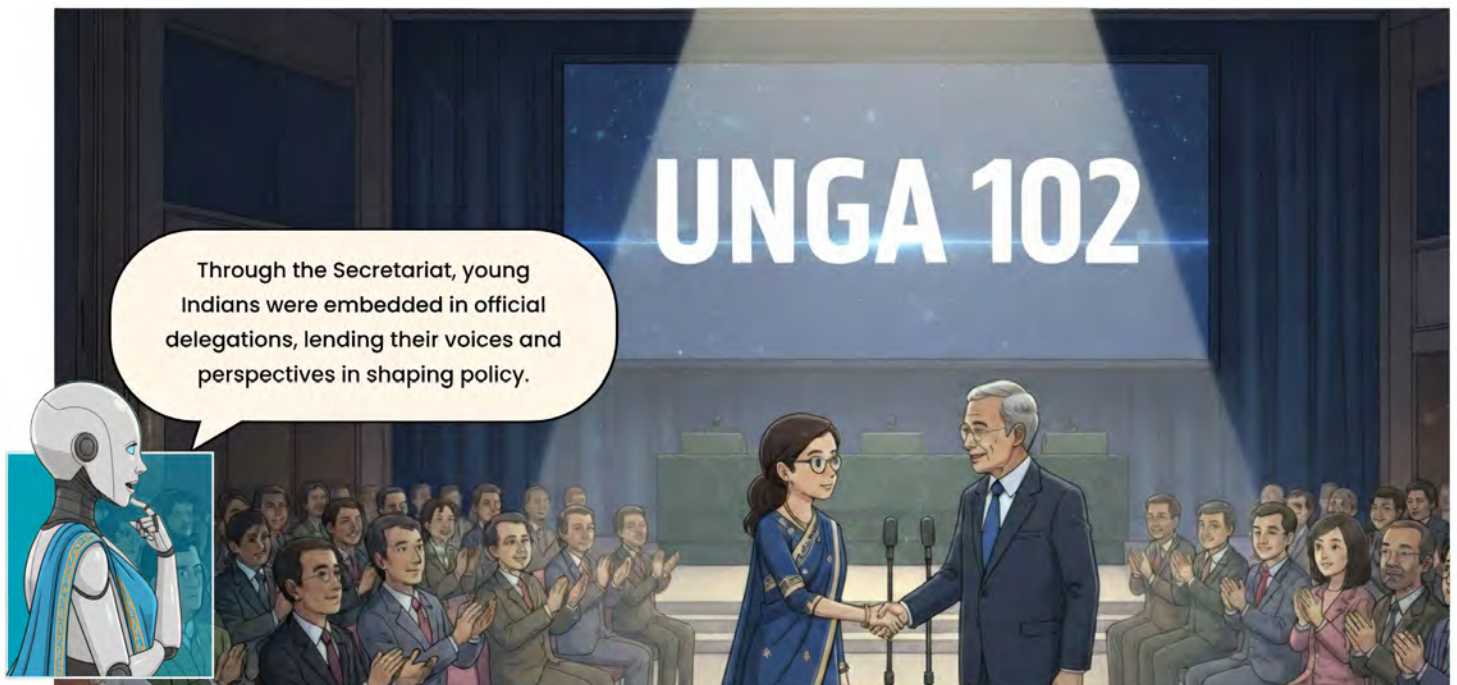
Well yes... but she wasn't a PM back in 2025. She was just like you, curious and determined.

In the 2030s, a small 'Futures Cell' was created. Their job was to imagine many futures and prepare India.

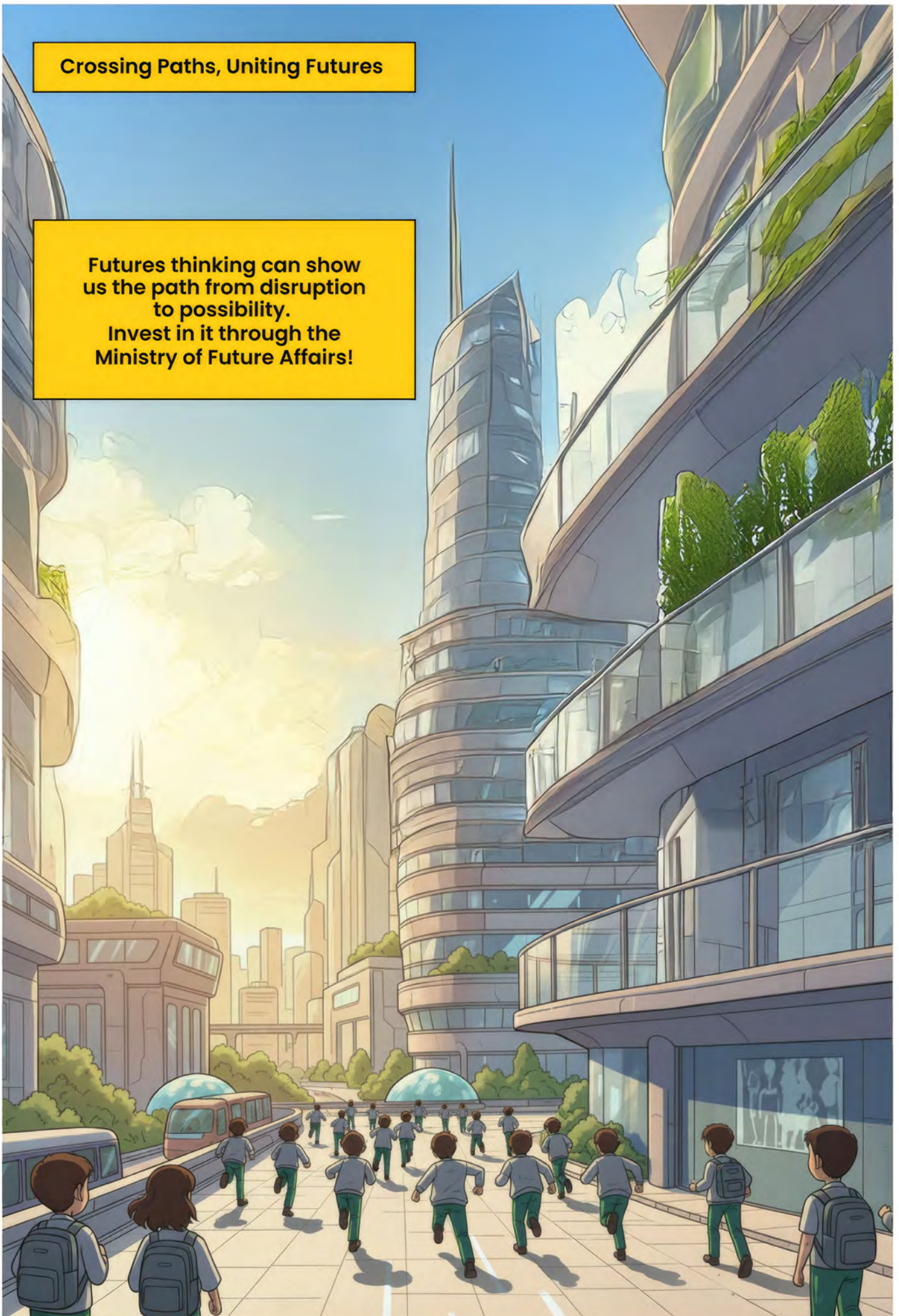




Crossing Paths, Uniting Futures
